

Today Catholics all over the world observe the **World Mission Sunday**. This annual observance was instituted 97 years ago in 1926 by Pope Pius XI's Papal decree. It gives us a chance to reflect on the importance of mission work for the life of the Church. It reminds us that we are one

with the Church around the world and that we are all committed to carrying on the mission of Christ, however different our situations may be.

The Church, according to Vatican Council II, is "missionary" in her very nature because her founder, Jesus Christ, was the first missionary.

God the Father sent God the Son, Incarnate in Jesus, His Christ, into the world with a message of God's love and salvation. Thus, the evangelizing mission of the Church is essentially the announcement of God's love, mercy, forgiveness, and salvation, as these are revealed to mankind through the life, death, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ our Lord.

On this Mission Sunday, let us learn to appreciate our missionary obligation and support the Church's missionary activities by leading transparent Christian lives, by fervent prayers, and by generous donations.


