Today's Gospel reminds us that being a disciple of Jesus means that we grow by Faith to become witnesses for Him. And bearing witness to Christ is an active, not passive, lifetime enterprise. One cannot be a disciple of Jesus at a distance any more than one can be a distant lover. To love Christ is to be drawn close to Him, to know Christ personally, to experience Him through the Bible, prayers and the Sacraments, and to inspire others to want to know Jesus. To help Christ is to share the Good News about Him with others. Blessed are we when we bring to others the gifts of love, peace, justice, tolerance, and mercy, thus becoming witnesses for Jesus Christ our Lord. The essence of our witness-bearing is, first, to state what we have seen and believed and to invite others to "come and see". We tell others about good restaurants, doctors, beauty salons, etc. Why isn't there the same fervor over inviting and encouraging people to come and participate in our Church activities? We hesitate to do so because of the false notion that talking about religion is taboo in our culture, or that religion is a private matter and shouldn't be shared with others. If we are not willing to invite others into this experience, what does that say about our experiences with Christ and with our Church?
