Ash Wednesday is coming up in few days, marking the beginning of the Lenten season. Lent is primarily a time of intense spiritual preparation for conquering our temptations, using the means Jesus used during His forty days of preparation in the desert for His public life. It is also the time for renewing our lives for the celebration of Easter with our Risen Lord who conquered sin and death by His suffering, death and Resurrection.

Every one of us is tempted to seek sinful pleasures, easy wealth and a position of authority, power and glory, and to use any means, even unjust or sinful ones, to gain these things. Jesus serves as a model for us in conquering temptations by strengthening Himself through prayer, penance and the effective use of the Word of God.

During this Lent, let us confront our evil tendencies with prayer especially by participating in the Holy Mass, by finding time to be with God every day of Lent, by being reconciled with God through the Sacrament of Reconciliation and reconciled with others by asking their forgiveness for our offenses against them; and by sharing our love with others through selfless and humble service, almsgiving and helping those in need.


